

Merry Christmas from the Staff and Students of LCBI!

The beginning of the winter season at LCBI High School has been an amazing journey, filled with opportunities to live, serve, worship, play, and learn together.

Here is a picture of that journey over the past few months:

Mid-term reporting in early November saw outcomes and indicators being achieved and success on assessments showing that the classroom activity and learning is challenging for students as well as nurturing and safe. Faculty continue to train in their respective International Baccalaureate areas.

Chapels continue to give us as an LCBI school family, a chance to enjoy a half hour of worship together every day. On Tuesday, November 4 we were visited by Rev. Tyler Gingrich, Youth Engagement Coordinator for Canadian Lutheran World Relief. Tyler's presentation shed light on the history of CLWR and it's humanitarian relief efforts, particularly in the areas of community development and refugee assistance.

The first few rounds of the Guidance counselling cycle with the Grade 12's has finished; so far over 85% of the class will be going to university and technical schools in the fall of 2015. Those who are choosing to work next year will be guided through the resume and cover letter process and have the opportunity to prep for interviews as well.

Our staff and students continue to participate in "mandatory" volunteering during our Take-Out-Tuesday program. This is a very special program to campus and we cherish this afternoon every month. In particular, we travel to Saskatoon every month and ALL students have an opportunity to prepare lunch and serve the noon meal to those who are homeless or living in poverty at the Friendship Inn. This is a favourite placement.

SRC continues to be very busy planning Fruit Nights, leading Praise and Worship, leading Wednesday Night Activities and generally being helpful during home tournaments and events

The campus lives in anticipation of what is next to come, and we live together in the hope of the One to come. Blessings to you all as we worship during this Advent season!
